

- Coordinate and Build Relationships























# This Way ONward

## Recruitment



### **2021** Recruitment

Information Sessions: Hosted on Run-The-World

### Applications:

- Online
- Open February and close end of March

### Interviews:

- In March and early April
- **Booked** online
- By phone, facetime, MS teams





























### 1. Job Training

- April- June
- Once a week for two hours
- Workshops offered twice/week
- Store tours
- **Mock Interviews**
- Apply for Internship
- Interview for Internship
- Unpaid
- **Old Navy Mentors**

### 2. Internship

- June August
- Internship is 10 weeks, 12 hours per week, and paid
- On-the-job coaching and support
- Not Guaranteed































## **Volunteer Mentors**

- Old Navy employees volunteer throughout the job training as mentors
- Relationship building
- Coaching
- Key role in:
  - Mock Interviews
  - Tours
  - Interviews































## **Client Support**

## **Job Training**

- Intake Assessment
- Follow up with clients by phone, email and text
- Attendance, participation in workshops, needs, and general check-in

## **Internship**

## "Job Coach" Support

- On-the-Job coaching
  - Receive feedback from Store Leaders
- Advocate for the youth
- Youth participate in three touch base workshops during 10 week internship with peers
- Exit interviews





























## **Outcomes**

### 2019

- 53 interns hired across 17 stores
- 53 interns completed internship
- 28 interns converted to PPT/ seasonal employees
- 75% reported increases in soft skills
- 64% reported increases in confidence

### 2020

- 26 youth hired via associate model with Old Navy
- 19 remained with the company by March 2021




























# **Program Overview**

- 13 Neet Youth per year
- 60 hours of life and skills and pre-employment training
- 4 weeks in store placement of 20-30 hours per week
- Stipend paid by Starbucks
- Coordinate Program with:
  - Starbucks (corporate, local and store managers)
  - Woods homes
  - Counsellors 2 week program





















# **Finding candidates**

OY vs Work Placement







## **Pre-Screen Process**

- Availability and Reliability
- Commitment
- Making sure child care needs, transportation needs and learning needs are taken care prior to beginning the program
- NEET youth (few High School candidate exceptions)







# **Curriculum and Supports**

- YEC Workshops
- Prepare targeted resume for Starbucks and conduct mock interview
- Pre-employment/lifeskills workshops and webinars
- Food Safe and WHMIS
- Offer snacks, provide hygiene items if necessary
- Fair entry referrals when necessary, bank account support, tax returns, library cards, etc.

# In person follow ups and supports

- Watch the youth in action
- Check in with the managers
- Provide support







## **Outcomes 2017-2019**

- 72% Completed program
- 30% hired by Starbucks after program completed
- 8% were offered jobs by Starbucks, but declined
- 5% were supported to find other jobs
- 15% went back to school
